Invitation

On behalf of the IOBC-WPRS Working group "Integrated Plant Protection in Fruit Crops" Sub Group "Pome Fruit Diseases", you are cordially invited to the forthcoming 11th International IOBC-WPRS Workshop on Pome Fruit Diseases that will take place from 26 to 30 June 2017 in Jūrmala, Latvia.

The workshop takes place every 3 years and aims to bring together the latest advances in research of pome fruit diseases, to provide an opportunity for exchange of information and ideas and to stimulate common research and collaboration.

The workshop program includes oral and poster sessions, a meeting with growers and advisors and a one-day excursion.

Proposed topics, relevant to integrated disease control in pome fruits

Oral and poster presentations may include

- diagnostic tools in pome fruit pathology;
- biology and epidemiology of apple and pear diseases;
- host-plant resistance and biodiversity;
- bacterial diseases of apple and pear;
- canker diseases of apple and pear;
- brown spot of pear;
- monitoring and forecasting infection risks;
- control methods (biocontrol, chemical, alternative, physical, sanitation);
- postharvest diseases.

Special attention will be given to poster presentations in plenary discussions during the meeting.

During the workshop there will be a special symposium named "Sustainable orchard disease management" where also growers and advisors from Latvia and neighbouring countries have been invited to attend. The symposium will include three invited talks on 1) Tree management, 2) Spray application, and 3) Control strategies followed by a general discussion.

Prior to the 11th International IOBC-WPRS Workshop on Pome Fruit Diseases, a meeting will be organized by the **Lenticel rot group**, which is an open discussion group with the main goal to discuss the latest research results related to storage diseases. Abstracts

Abstracts must be sent to the local workshop convenor <u>regina.rancane@laapc.lv</u> by 30 March 2017. Abstracts will be reviewed for acceptance by a scientific committee, and authors will be notified by 21 April 2017 whether their abstract has been accepted. Submitted abstracts will be printed in the book of abstracts handed out to participants during the meeting.

Presentations

Authors may express their choice of oral or poster presentation; however, the scientific committee may invite the authors to change this choice.

Publications in IOBC-WPRS Bulletin

The authors of accepted abstracts will be expected to prepare and submit online a full manuscript or a two-page extended abstract, two months after the workshop (30 August 2017). After editing, the manuscripts or extended abstracts will be published in an IOBC-WPRS Bulletin. Delegates who are not members of IOBC-WPRS will have one year membership of IOBC included in the registration. The proceedings published in the IOBC-WPRS Bulletin will be available online only for IOBC-WPRS members.
